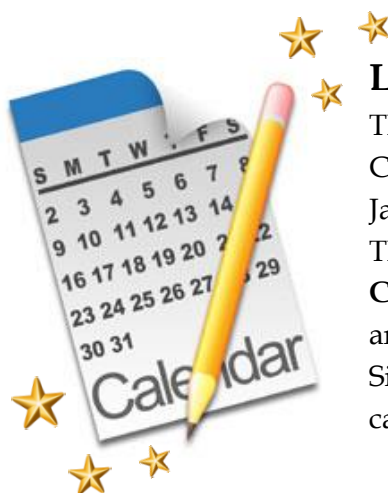

Rushen Silver Band will be holding their Annual General Meeting on Thursday 17th November at 7.45pm at the Bandroom.

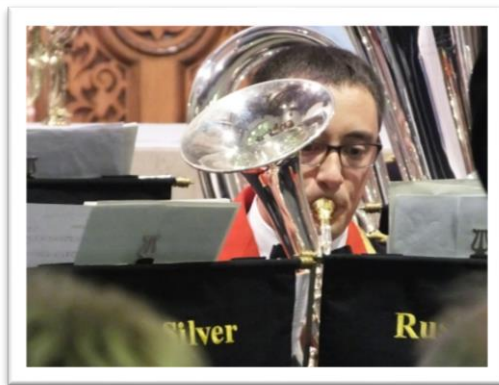
Everyone is welcome and encouraged to attend.

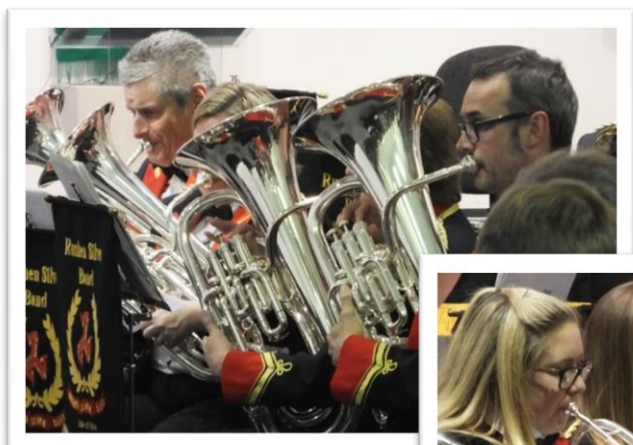
At St Columba's Church on Friday 21st October, the Band performed the following pieces to a full audience: -

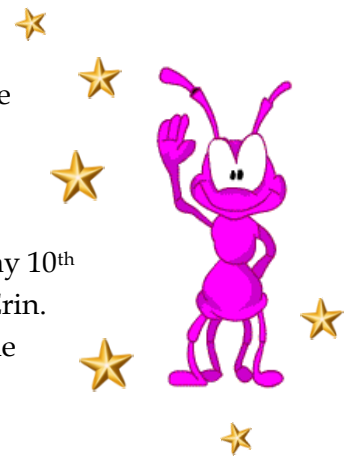




Events from the Friends of the Band
