## Gala Concert with Mr Richard Evans

The Band held a Gala Concert in October with our guest conductor and Band Musical Advisor Mr Richard Evans. The concert, which was the first the Band had played at the Kings Court Theatre at King William's College in Castletown, was a tremendous success and really appreciated by a very good audience on the night.

The Band had once again had three practices with Mr Evans on the lead up to the concert, and Mr Evans was enthusiastic as ever with not only in his conducting of the Band but also his storytelling along the way. The musical programme of the evening was a varied collection of pieces to show the ability and talents of the Band and included performances from the Band's training band, Ballafesson Brass. The concert culminated with both the senior Band and Ballafesson Brass taking to the floor for the final three pieces, with over 50 players under Mr Evans baton.



The Band are extremely grateful to the Manx Lottery Trust for awarding a grant to the Band to cover the expenditure in putting the concert on which has enabled the Band to put the income raised to their next big project.

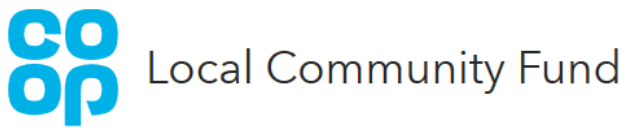
Members of the Band will also be playing carols during the event to get everyone in the festive spirit. We hope you can join us.
