

#### **Remembrance Sunday 2020**

The Isle of Man was the only place in the UK where a full turnout for Remembrance Sunday was possible, with the UK in lockdown due to the COVID-19 outbreak. The Band were pleased that a gap in the rain appeared briefly, so that they were able to lead the parade for the Port Erin Branch of the Royal British Legion. Our cornet players were also required to play the Last Post and Reveille at a number of Remembrance Services in our local churches and Gardens of Remembrance both on Remembrance Sunday and Remembrance Day too.



#### **Band Christmas Concert**

The Band are holding their Christmas Concert once again this year at the Erin Arts Centre on the evening of Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> November 2020.

The concert will again be the Band's first concert of the festive season, with a further 16 engagements on the lead up to Christmas Day 2020. As ever, the Band have a great concert planned to put everybody in the Christmas spirit.

Tickets for the concerts sold quicker than ever this year, with the concert being sold out just a few days after the tickets went on general release, so you are very lucky if you managed to get one. ### Joint Concert with Ballafesson Brass

After raising thousands of pounds for other local charities during 2020, the Band held its own Autumn Concert with its training band Ballafesson Brass at Rushen Primary School on Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> October. The concert helped to raise funds for the general upkeep of the Band.





Having endured many disruptions to its calendar throughout 2020, the Band have still managed to keep a high profile and remained active by hosting virtual concerts and showing highlights of some of our recent concerts during the lockdown period.

The concert showed the strength in numbers within the

Band in general from those still learning, those playing with Ballafesson Brass and those in the senior Band. Both bands played individually and the concert finished with both bands playing a finale together, providing a band in the region of 50 players.

Whilst the concert was a great success for both bands and for the monies raised, it has been hoped that our Musical Advisor, Richard Evans, would be joining us again, but due to the lockdown in place, he was unbale to journey to the Island on this occasion. However, it is hoped that he will be able to return again in 2021.
