Band raises funds for Sailing for the Disabled

The Band raised £500 for local charity 'Sailing for the Disabled' at a recent concert. The event, which took place at St Columba's Catholic Church in Port Erin on Monday 24th January, marked the start of the Band's busy 2022 calendar.

Over recent years, it has become tradition that the Band's first concert of the year is used to raise



money for local charities, with previous concerts benefitting 'Southern Befrienders' and 'Graih'. 'Sailing for the Disabled' was chosen for last year's event, but this had to be postponed due to COVID-19, and the Band was delighted to be able to reschedule this year.



The Band included in their musical programme well known pieces 'Cornfield Rock', 'Pastorale', 'MacArthur Park' and 'The Lost Chord'. In addition, principal euphonium Martin Norbury played 'Varied Mood' with his usual style and gusto; whilst Band President & Compere, Graham Easton, ably assisted Jo Kinley (flugel horn) on Bb Bass with a rendition of 'Love's Old Sweet Song'.

Band Chairman, Chris Weldon, said: 'Sailing for the Disabled are a fantastic local charity who do so much for people with disabilities, giving them confidence in trying new experiences, and it was a pleasure to be able to help them.'

On their Facebook page, Sailing for the Disabled said: 'What an honour for our charity this event was. Rushen Silver Band put on an evening of beauty and donating to our cause. It was a great atmosphere, lovely banter and often very

moving.


Concert at Peel Cathedral


The Band were very pleased to be invited back to provide a concert at Peel Cathedral in February this year.
